George Plies to India. Aug 16th: Pindi - Karachi - London. Weather: Prior to our arriving there had been heavy snows, further east in Baltoro no expedition was is acceptul. Our errer experienced music weather. 1/2 days good folled by 3/4 mixed led weather. Temperatures were extremely high 8000Pt = 90°; Preezing only occured above 16,000Ft during night time, it rever seemed to freque during the day, Snow routes were obiously dangerous and laborious. Our main reasons for retreat where the illnesses of A. Bowman, and A.Swann, the lead dimbers. hack of funds prevented recuperation in Pindi, dreent hotels cost Z15 plus per night. Both Swann & Bouman were diagnosed having acute gastroenteritus, worms and bood poisoning although great precautions were taken. This is not the first expedition to experience particularly had health problems in the Humpa Valley is DougScatts team in 85.
